Seminar description

Urban air quality in New Zealand is dominated by the burning of solid fuel, mostly wood, for domestic heating. We have very little heavy industry and traffic is only a pollution problem in major city centres. New Zealand's geographic isolation also means that there is little or no long-range transport of pollution from other countries. This presents two advantages; a large proportion of the population whose exposure to pollution comes from a single source and the ability to study pollution behaviour without interference from outside sources. This talk will present the results of research projects aiming to capitalise on both these advantages.
